REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY


WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on Lincoln General Insurance Company, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of Lincoln General Insurance Company, P.O. Box 3709, York, Pennsylvania, for a period of one year on the grounds that the company is in an unsound financial condition or in such a condition as to render its further transaction of insurance in this state injurious to policyholders or to the public; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on May 20, 2013, informing Lincoln General Insurance that it must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that it has corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective June 22, 2013; and

WHEREAS Lincoln General Insurance Company has failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Lincoln General Insurance Company be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective June 22, 2013, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-116(c) and 116(e) and Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(c).
