REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on August 2, 2012, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of Lumbermens Mutual Casualty Company (Lumbermens), 1 Corporate Drive, Suite 200, Lake Zurich, Illinois 60047-8945, and American Manufacturers Mutual Insurance Company (American Manufacturers), 1 Corporate Drive, Suite 200, Lake Zurich, Illinois 60047-8945, for a period of one year on the grounds that the companies are in an unsound financial condition or in such a condition as to render the further transaction of insurance in this state injurious to policyholders or to the public; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on June 26, 2013, informing Lumbermens and American Manufacturers that they must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that they have corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective August 2, 2013; and

WHEREAS Lumbermens and American Manufacturers have failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that they have corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Lumbermens and American Manufacturers be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective August 2, 2013, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-3-115, 26-3-116(e) and Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(c).
