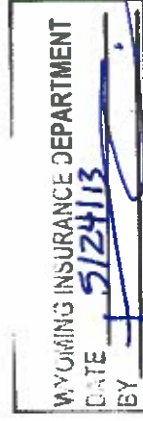
**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF PETITIONER'S
APPLICATION FOR ENTRY OF DEFAULT**

I, James S. Mitchell, being first duly sworn upon my oath, declare and state that the following facts are true and correct to the best of my information and belief:

1. I am the staff attorney for the Petitioner, the Wyoming Insurance Department.
2. A Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause seeking revocation of Respondent's non-resident insurance license on the grounds that the Respondent's home state license is not active, that Respondent was terminated from appointment and Kansas filed a RIRS for demonstrating lack of fitness or trustworthiness and unfair insurance practices act violation, were filed herein on the 24th day of April, 2013. The Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause were served upon Respondent on April 24, 2013 by placing copies of the same in the United States Mail, postage prepaid, certified, return receipt requested, addressed to Respondent at her last address of record with the Department. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-2-126(c) "mailed notice is deemed to have been served when addressed to the person to be notified at his address last of record with the department and deposited, postage paid, in a mail depository of the United States post office."
3. Respondent has failed, neglected or refused to interpose, answer or otherwise plead, and the last day for such answer or pleading has since passed.
4. All of the allegations contained in the Petition and the Notice and Order to Show Cause are true and correct, to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.
5. The facts alleged in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause, if deemed to be true, are sufficient to establish grounds for the revocation of the Respondent's non-resident insurance producer license pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-107, and 26-9-211.

DEFAULT ORDER

THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER came before the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to a Petition for Default Judgment filed herein by the above-named Petitioner; and the Insurance Commissioner having examined said petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof, and being duly advised in the premises, does hereby make and enter the following findings and order:

1. A Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause were served on the above-named Respondent on April 24, 2013, when said documents were placed in the United States Mail, postage prepaid, certified, return receipt requested, and addressed to the Respondent at her last known address.
2. The facts alleged in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause are deemed to be true, and are sufficient to establish grounds for the revocation of the Respondent's insurance producer license pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-107 and 26-9-211.
3. Pursuant to the Wyoming Department of Insurance Rules and Regulations, Chapter 32, §§ 7 and 9, entry of default in this matter is appropriate and such default should therefore be entered.

THEREFORE, upon request of the Petitioner, default is hereby entered against the Respondent, Josette M. Wyatt, as provided in Chapter 32, §§ 7 and 9 of the Wyoming Department of Insurance Rules and Regulations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Wyoming non-resident producer license held by Respondent is **REVOKED** pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall immediately surrender her Wyoming nonresident insurance producer license to the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner.
