REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on December 7, 2010, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of American Community Mutual Insurance Company, 39201 Seven Mile Road, Livonia, MI 48152-1094, for a period of one year on the grounds that the company is in an unsound financial condition or in such a condition as to render its further transaction of insurance in this state injurious to policyholders or to the public, which suspension was extended for an additional year on November 17, 2011; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on November 5, 2012, informing American Community Mutual Insurance Company that it must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that it has corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective December 7, 2012; and

WHEREAS American Community Mutual Insurance Company has failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of American Community Mutual Insurance Company be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective December 7, 2012, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(c).
