**Re: Denial of Application for Nonresident Producer License
Docket 12-11**

Dear Mr. Anderson:

The Wyoming Department of Insurance hereby denies your application for a nonresident producer license for property and casualty lines of authority due to the fact that you have a pending criminal charge.

Wyoming Statute 26-9-211(a) provides, in part, that the commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer's license based on using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere and for having an insurance producer license denied, suspended or revoked in any other state. The National Association of Insurance Commissioners' data base shows that you were denied licensure in the state of Virginia and a copy of the March 6, 2012, denial was obtained from that agency.

Following proof of the final disposition of the pending criminal matter, the Department will consider a new application for licensure.

You have a right to appeal this denial by requesting a hearing pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-2-125. A request for hearing must be made within 30 days of the date of this letter and should make reference to or include a copy of this denial letter. A request for hearing should be directed to my attention.
