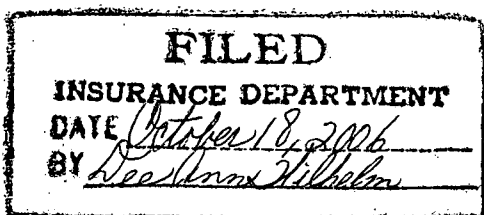

PETITION FOR NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW the Wyoming Department of Insurance, acting by and through James S. Mitchell, Staff Attorney, and pursuant to W.S. §§ 26-1-103, 26-2-109 and 26-2-111, and Chapter 32 § 4 of the Wyoming Insurance Department Regulations and Rules for Practice and Procedure Before the Department; and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, W.S. § 16-3-101 *et seq.*, herewith moves the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner for the issuance of a Notice and Order to Show Cause directed to James Frederick Besel, whose last reported address was 1001-AE Harmony Road, No. 173, Fort Collins, CO 80525. As cause for this Petition, the Wyoming Insurance Department states and alleges as follows:

1. The Wyoming Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to W.S. § 26-1-103, W.S. § 26-1-108, and W.S. § 26-9-211.
2. Respondent is licensed by the Wyoming Department of Insurance as a nonresident producer, License No. 59124 issued July 31, 2002, with a renewal date of April 30, 2007. The Respondent's Individual ID is 45723 and his National Producer ID is 6782031.
3. The business records of the Department of Insurance show Respondent is affiliated with Mid-West National Life Insurance Company of Tennessee.
4. On or about September 13, 2006, the Colorado Division of Insurance notified the Wyoming Insurance Department that Respondent's Colorado resident license number 111277 was suspended on July 7, 2006, for non-payment of child support.
5. The Department advised Respondent by letter dated September 14, 2006, that the Colorado Division of Insurance had notified the Department of the July 7, 2006 suspension and requested that Respondent advise the Department of the status of his insurance license in the State of Colorado.



6. Pursuant to W.S. § 26-9-211(a)(ix) the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

7. Pursuant to W.S. § 26-9-211(a) (ii) the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating any insurance laws, or violating any regulation, subpoena or order of the commissioner or of another state's insurance commissioner.


8. Wyoming Statute § 26-9-216 requires that a producer shall report to the commissioner any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction within 30 days of the final disposition of the matter. More than 30 days have passed since the Colorado Insurance Department suspended Respondent's license and the Wyoming Insurance Department has received no notification from Respondent; neither has Respondent responded to Petitioner's September 14, 2006 request for Colorado license status information.

WHEREFORE the Department of Insurance respectfully prays the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner to:

A. Suspend the Respondent's nonresident producer license for violation of W.S. § 26-9-211.

B. To enter such other and further relief as may be permitted by law.
