PETITION FOR NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW the Wyoming Department of Insurance, acting by and through Stephanie Bryant McGee, Deputy Commissioner, and pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-2-109 and 26-2-111, and Chapter 32 § 4 of the Wyoming Insurance Department Regulations and Rules for Practice and Procedure Before the Department; and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. § 16-3-101 *et seq.*, herewith moves the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner for the issuance of a Notice and Order to Show Cause directed to Ellen A. Bosetski, whose last reported address was 3461 Pine Forest Drive, Green Bay, WI 54313. As cause for this Petition, the Wyoming Insurance Department states and alleges as follows:

1. The Wyoming Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-1-108, and 26-9-211.
2. Respondent is licensed by the Wyoming Department of Insurance as a nonresident producer, License No. 157935 issued January 5, 2007, with a renewal date of March 31, 2009. The Respondent's Individual ID is 10063147 and her National Producer ID is 8955662.
3. The business records of the Department of Insurance show Respondent is not affiliated with any insurer.
4. On or about August 27, 2007, the Department received notification from the National Association of Insurance Commissioners ("NAIC") Regulatory Information Retrieval System ("RIRS") of an enforcement action against Respondent in the State of Kansas. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-214 Petitioner further investigated the matter.
5. Petitioner's investigation revealed that on June 14, 2007, Respondent's insurance producer license was revoked by her home state of Wisconsin for failure to pay taxes. A copy of

the Order of Revocation entered by the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance for the State of Wisconsin is on file herein.


6. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a)(ii), (viii) and (ix), the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating any insurance laws, or violating any regulation, subpoena or order of the commissioner or of another state's insurance commissioner; using fraudulent, coercive or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere; or having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

WHEREFORE the Department of Insurance respectfully prays the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner to:

A. Revoke the Respondent's nonresident producer license for violation of Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211.

B. To enter such other and further relief as may be permitted by law.
