PETITION FOR NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW the Wyoming Department of Insurance, acting by and through Stephanie Bryant McGee, Deputy Commissioner, and pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-1-103, 26-2-109 and 26-2-111, and Chapter 32 § 4 of the Wyoming Insurance Department Regulations and Rules for Practice and Procedure Before the Department; and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. § 16-3-101 *et seq.*, herewith moves the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner for the issuance of a Notice and Order to Show Cause directed to Danielle Sherece Clark, whose last reported address was 12482 Abrams Road 221, Dallas, TX 75243. As cause for this Petition, the Wyoming Insurance Department states and alleges as follows:

1. The Wyoming Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-1-103, 26-1-108, and 26-9-211.
2. Respondent is licensed by the Wyoming Department of Insurance as a nonresident producer, License No. 76468 issued July 19, 2004, with a renewal date of October 31, 2007. The Respondent's Individual ID is 63529 and her National Producer ID is 8099705.
3. The business records of the Department of Insurance show Respondent is not currently affiliated with any insurer.
4. On or about August 11, 2007, the Department received a RIRS notification from the NAIC reporting a disciplinary action taken against Respondent's license by the New York Department of Insurance. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-214 Petitioner further investigated the cause for termination.
5. Petitioner's investigation revealed that Respondent's license has been revoked in several states, including Texas, her home State. A copy of the Official Order of the Commissioner of Insurance of the State of Texas, issued on November 10, 2006, was requested and a copy of the same is on file herein. Said Default Order found that Denielle Sherece Clark

engaged in fraudulent or dishonest acts or practices, having been indicted in Dallas County, Texas for receiving unemployment wages, while holding employment and earning wages. Respondent's insurance license was revoked by the Texas Insurance Department.

6. More than 30 days have passed since Respondent's license was revoked in Texas and Respondent has failed to notify the Wyoming Insurance Department in violation of Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-216.


7. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a)(ii) and (ix) the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating any regulation, subpoena or order of the commissioner or of another state's insurance commissioner; or having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province or territory.

WHEREFORE the Department of Insurance respectfully prays the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner to:

A. Revoke the Respondent's nonresident producer license for violation of Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211.

B. To enter such other and further relief as may be permitted by law.
