DEFAULT ORDER AND JUDGMENT

THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER came before the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to a Petition for Default Order and Judgment filed herein by the above-named Petitioner; and the Insurance Commissioner having examined said petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof, and being duly advised in the premises, does hereby make and enter the following findings and order:

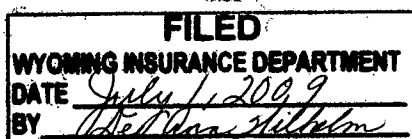
1. This matter was commenced on May 21, 2009, by the filing of a Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause. The Insurance Commissioner reviewed said Petition and issued a Notice and Order to Show Cause, filed herein on May 26, 2009. The Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause were served on the above-named Respondent on May 26, 2009, when said documents were placed in the United States Mail, certified mail, return receipt requested, and addressed to the Respondent at her last known address.

2. Respondent has failed to maintain the address of record with the Department for service of process as shown by the return of the certified mail herein.

3. The Notice and Order to Show Cause directed the Respondent to file an answer or other responsive pleading within twenty (20) days after May 28, 2009, the effective date of service of the Petition and Notice upon the Respondent. More than twenty (20) days have elapsed since the effective date of service.

4. Since the Respondent has failed to answer or otherwise plead or appear in this matter, the allegations set forth in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause filed herein on May 21, 2009, shall be and the same are hereby deemed to be true.

5. All facts alleged in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause are deemed to be true. The facts alleged in Counts III and IV are sufficient in and of themselves to establish grounds for the revocation of the Respondent's insurance producer license pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-1-107 and Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211.




6. Pursuant to the Wyoming Department of Insurance Rules and Regulations, Chapter 32 §§ 7 and 9, entry of default in this matter is appropriate and such default should therefore be entered.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. The Default of Respondent Mary Janine Donaldson entered.
2. The allegations against Respondent as stated in the Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause in this matter in Counts I and II are taken as and are assumed to be true and correct. The allegations against Respondent as stated in Counts III and IV are proven by the return of the certified mail marked undeliverable.
3. Based upon the allegations contained in the Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause, any insurance producer license held in the name of Respondent is **REVOKED** pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a).
4. Respondent shall immediately surrender her producer's license to the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner.
5. Respondent shall pay a fine in the sum two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for violation of each Count set forth in the Petition for Order to Show Cause, a total of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to the Wyoming Department of Insurance


