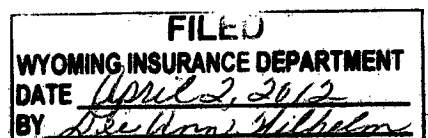
ORDER OF REVOCATION

THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER came before the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to a Petition of Deputy Commissioner Stephanie Bryant McGee, Petitioner herein; and the Insurance Commissioner having examined said petition and being duly advised in the premises, does hereby make and enter the following findings and order:

1. This matter was commenced on July 21, 2011, by the filing of a Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause seeking revocation of Respondent's nonresident adjuster license due to receipt of an insufficient funds check in payment of her licensing renewal fees. The Insurance Commissioner reviewed said Petition and issued a Notice and Order to Show Cause, filed herein on July 21, 2011. The Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause were served on the above-named Respondent on July 21, 2011, when said documents were placed in the United States Mail, certified mail, return receipt requested, and addressed to the Respondent at her last known address.

2. Respondent responded to said Notice and Order to Show Cause by letter dated August 16, 2011, and represented that she was willing to enter into a consent order to resolve the matter.

3. Letters dated August 24, 2011, and October 26, 2011, were sent to Respondent, both by certified mail, return receipt requested. Signed return receipts for both mailings were received back in the Department. Both letters included a proposed Stipulation and Consent Order for an amicable resolution of this matter. The October 26, 2011, letter gave notice that if the matter was not resolved within 20 days from the date thereof, revocation of Respondent's license would be pursued.



4. More than twenty days have passed and no further response to either letter has been received from Respondent.

5. Since the Respondent has failed to further respond or appear in this matter, the allegations set forth in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause filed herein on July 21, 2011, shall be and the same are hereby deemed to be true.

6. The facts alleged in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause, that are deemed to be true, are sufficient to establish grounds for the revocation of the Respondent's insurance adjuster license pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-1-107 and Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

1. The Wyoming nonresident adjuster license held in the name of Respondent Matilda Hernandez is hereby **REVOKED**;

2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of Two Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$230.00);

3. Respondent shall immediately surrender her Wyoming insurance adjuster license to the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner.


