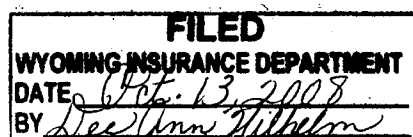

PETITION FOR NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW the Wyoming Department of Insurance, acting by and through Stephanie Bryant McGee, Deputy Commissioner, and pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-2-109 and 26-2-111; Chapter 32 § 4 of the Wyoming Insurance Department Regulations and Rules for Practice and Procedure Before the Department; and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. § 16-3-101 *et seq.*, herewith moves the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner for the issuance of a Notice and Order to Show Cause directed to Hector Ernesto Mendoza, whose last reported address was 2980 Brando Drive, San Diego, CA 92154. As cause for this Petition, the Wyoming Insurance Department states and alleges as follows:

1. The Wyoming Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-1-108, 26-9-208 and 26-9-211.
2. Respondent is licensed by the Wyoming Department of Insurance as a nonresident producer, License No. 173594 issued March 14, 2008, with a renewal date of March 31, 2010. The Respondent's Individual ID is 10107860 and his National Producer ID is 8234058.
3. The business records of the Department of Insurance show Respondent is not currently affiliated with any insurer.
4. On or about September 24, 2008, a State RIRS Notification was received from the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) notifying the Department that a regulatory action had been taken against Respondent Hector Ernesto Mendoza's license in the state of California.
5. Petitioner's investigation of the matter reported by the NAIC revealed that the California Department of Insurance entered an Order of Summary Revocation on August 19, 2008, revoking the license and licensing rights of Respondent effective September 19, 2008.



The Order was based on the fact that Respondent was convicted upon a plea of nolo contendere of possession of marijuana for sale, a felony in California.

6. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-208(a)(i) a condition for nonresident licensing in Wyoming is that the person is currently licensed as a resident and is in good standing in his home state. Respondent's home state is California.


7. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a)(ii), (vi) and (ix), the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for violating any insurance laws, or violating any regulation, subpoena or order of the commissioner or of another state's insurance commissioner; for having been convicted of a felony; or for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

WHEREFORE the Department of Insurance respectfully prays the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner to:

A. Revoke the Respondent's nonresident producer license for violation of Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-9-208 and 26-9-211.

B. To enter such other and further relief as may be permitted by law.
