PETITION FOR NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW the Wyoming Department of Insurance, acting by and through Stephanie Bryant McGee, Deputy Commissioner, and pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-2-109 and 26-2-111, and Chapter 32 § 4 of the Wyoming Insurance Department Regulations and Rules for Practice and Procedure Before the Department; and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. § 16-3-101 *et seq.*, herewith moves the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner for the issuance of a Notice and Order to Show Cause directed to Hanna Marie Olsen, whose last reported address was 8668 Magnolia Hill Way, Elk Grove, CA 95624. As cause for this Petition, the Wyoming Insurance Department states and alleges as follows:

1. The Wyoming Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-1-108, 26-9-211 and 26-9-216.
2. Respondent is licensed by the Wyoming Department of Insurance as a Nonresident Producer, License No. 89571 issued December 19, 2005, with a renewal date of July 31, 2008. The Respondent's Individual ID is 77156, and her National Producer ID is 8174584.
3. The business records of the Department of Insurance show Respondent is not currently affiliated with any insurer.
4. On or about June 18, 2007, Petitioner received a NAIC State RIRS notification of a disciplinary action taken in the State of California against Hanna Marie Olsen. California is Respondent's home state.
5. Petitioner's investigation revealed that an Order of Summary Revocation was entered by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of California revoking the license and licensing rights of Respondent Hanna Marie Olsen as of June 1, 2007, on the grounds that she was convicted on a plea of nolo contendere of attempting to elude a peace officer, a felony in California. A copy of said Order is on file herein.

6. Following the revocation of Respondent's license in her home state of California, other states, including Kansas and North Dakota, have revoked her license.

7. More than 30 days have passed since Respondent's license was revoked in California and Respondent has failed to notify the Wyoming Insurance Department in violation of Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-216.


8. Pursuant to W.S. § 26-9-211(a) (vi) and (a)(ix), the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for having been convicted of a felony; or, for having any insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province or territory.

WHEREFORE the Department of Insurance respectfully prays the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner to:

A. Revoke the Respondent's nonresident producer license for violation of Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-9-211 and 26-9-216.

B. To enter such other and further relief as may be permitted by law.
