

ORDER OF REVOCATION

THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER came before the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to a Petition of Deputy Commissioner Stephanie Bryant McGee, Petitioner herein; and the Insurance Commissioner having examined said petition and being duly advised in the premises, does hereby make and enter the following findings and order:

- 1. This matter was commenced on May 3, 2011, by the filing of a Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause. The Insurance Commissioner reviewed said Petition and issued a Notice and Order to Show Cause, filed herein on May 3, 2011. The Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause were served on the above-named Respondent on May 3, 2011, when said documents were placed in the United States Mail, certified mail, return receipt requested, and addressed to the Respondent at his last known address.
- 2. On or about May 16, 2011, a letter dated May 12, 2011, was received from Respondent in response to the Notice and Order to Show Cause. The May 12, 2011, letter stated in part, "I am willing to do whatever I can to make this right in the eyes of the Wyoming Department of Insurance."
- 3. On June 28, 2011, a proposed Consent Order was mailed to Respondent under cover of a letter dated the same day wherein Respondent was advised that if he were in agreement with the terms and conditions set forth therein, upon execution of the same and receipt of a certified check or money order in the amount of \$350.00 (\$100.00 to replace the returned check and a \$250.00 civil penalty), the same would be presented to the Commissioner for consideration.
- 4. No response to the June 28, 2011, letter being received, a second letter was sent on October 27, 2011, again by certified mail, forwarding a duplicate copy of the proposed Stipulation and advising that unless the matter was resolved within 20 days thereof, the



Department would pursue revocation of Respondent's Wyoming insurance license. More than twenty days have passed and no further response has been received from Respondent.

- 5. Since the Respondent has failed to further respond or appear in this matter, the allegations set forth in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause filed herein on May 3, 2011, shall be and the same are hereby deemed to be true.
- 6. The facts alleged in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause, that are deemed to be true, are sufficient to establish grounds for the revocation of the Respondent's insurance adjuster license pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-1-107 and Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The Wyoming insurance adjuster license held in the name of Respondent Dan Randall Parker, Jr. is hereby **REVOKED**;
 - 2. Respondent shall pay a three hundred fifty dollar (\$350.00) civil penalty;
- 3. Respondent shall immediately surrender his Wyoming insurance adjuster license to the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner.
