**REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on January 9, 2009, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company, 3440 Lehigh Street, Allentown, Pennsylvania 18103-7001, for a period of one year on the grounds that the company was placed in rehabilitation by the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania on January 6, 2009, upon the petition of the Pennsylvania Insurance Commissioner; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on December 9, 2009, informing Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company that it must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that it has corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective January 9, 2010; and

WHEREAS Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company has failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective January 9, 2010, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(c).
