ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company, 3440 Lehigh Street, Allentown, Pennsylvania 18103, holds a Certificate of Authority to transact the business of insurance in the State of Wyoming as a life & annuities and disability insurer; and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania entered an Order on January 6, 2009, granting the Pennsylvania Insurance Commissioner's Petition for Rehabilitation; and

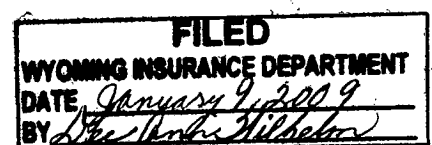
WHEREAS, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-116(e), the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming, without advance notice or hearing, may immediately suspend the certificate of authority of an insurer as to which proceedings for receivership, conservatorship, rehabilitation, or other delinquency proceedings have been commenced in any state by the public insurance supervisory official of that state;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company be and the same hereby is suspended for a period of one year;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(b), that during the suspension period Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company shall not solicit or write any new business in this state but shall file its annual statement, pay fees, licenses and taxes as required under the Wyoming Insurance Code, and may service its business already in force in the State of Wyoming as if the certificate of authority had continued in full force.

PROVIDED that during the suspension period such Certificate of Authority may be reinstated upon Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company's motion and adequate proof to the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that said company has solved the problems which led to the issuance of the Pennsylvania Order; and

PROVIDED, however, that if Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company fails to request a hearing and prove to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has solved the problems which caused the entry of the Pennsylvania Order, its Certificate of Authority shall terminate at the end of the one-year period and shall become permanently revoked pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118.



IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Penn Treaty Network America Insurance Company shall forthwith surrender and deliver its Certificate of Authority to transact the business of insurance in the State of Wyoming to the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming within ten (10) days after receipt of this Order of Suspension pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-113(c).
