**REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY**

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on January 8, 2009, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of Standard Life Insurance Company of Indiana, 10689 North Pennsylvania Street, Indianapolis, IN 46280; for a period of one year on the grounds that the company was in an unsound financial condition or in such a condition as to render its further transaction of insurance in the state injurious to policyholders or to the public; and

WHEREAS the above-referenced suspension was extended for an additional year from January 8, 2011, on December 29, 2010; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on December 2, 2011, informing Standard Life Insurance Company of Indiana that it must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that it has corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective January 8, 2012; and

WHEREAS Standard Life Insurance Company of Indiana has failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Standard Life Insurance Company of Indiana be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective January 8, 2012, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-116 and Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(c).
