REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on August 30, 2006, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation, 27310 Ranch Road 12, Dripping Springs, TX 78620, for a period of one year on the grounds that an Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction was entered in the District Court of Travis County, Texas, 126<sup>th</sup> Judicial District, on August 1, 2006, finding, *inter alia*, that Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation is insolvent; and


WHEREAS Extensions of Suspension of Certificate of Authority were entered on August 29, 2007, and August 21, 2008, each extending the suspension of the Certificate of Authority for an additional year; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on July 29, 2009, informing Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation that it must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that it has corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective August 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation has failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Vesta Fire Insurance Corporation be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective August 30, 2009, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-3-116(e) and 26-3-118(c).
