



In addition to the general requirements, any resident of Wyoming who is **CURRENTLY BEING TREATED** for one or more of the “presumptive” conditions noted below is not required to submit refusal of health insurance coverage by one health insurance company with the application to the Wyoming Health Insurance Pool.
