REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY


WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Order on September 19, 2011, instituting the suspension of the Certificate of Authority of Western Insurance Company, 9065 South 1300 East, Salt Lake City, UT 84094, for a period of one year on the grounds that the Utah Insurance Commissioner entered a Rehabilitation Order on August 25, 2011, and that subsequent thereto a Liquidation Order, Declaration of Insolvency and Restraining Order was entered in the Third Judicial District Court of Salt Lake County, State of Utah on September 13, 2011; and

WHEREAS the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming issued an Intent to Revoke Certificate of Authority on August 15, 2012, informing Western Insurance Company that it must demonstrate to the Insurance Commissioner that it has corrected the conditions which resulted in the suspension of its Certificate of Authority, and if such was not done, the Certificate of Authority of said company would terminate and be permanently revoked effective September 19, 2012; and

WHEREAS Western Insurance Company has failed to demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Wyoming that it has corrected the conditions leading to the issuance of the Order of Suspension of Certificate of Authority;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Certificate of Authority of Western Insurance Company be and the same hereby is permanently revoked effective September 19, 2012, pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-115, 26-3-116(e) and Wyo. Stat. § 26-3-118(c).
