DEFAULT ORDER

THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER came before the Insurance Commissioner pursuant to a Petition for Default Judgment filed herein by the above-named Petitioner; and the Insurance Commissioner having examined said petition and the affidavit filed in support thereof, and being duly advised in the premises, does hereby make and enter the following findings and order:

1. A Petition and Notice and Order to Show Cause were served on the above-named Respondent on July 11, 2012, when said documents were placed in the United States Mail, postage prepaid, certified, return receipt requested, and addressed to the Respondent at her last known address.

2. The facts alleged in the Petition for Notice and Order to Show Cause are deemed to be true, and are sufficient to establish grounds for the revocation of the Respondent's insurance producer license pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-107 and 26-9-211.


3. Pursuant to the Wyoming Department of Insurance Rules and Regulations, Chapter 32, §§ 7 and 9, entry of default in this matter is appropriate and such default should therefore be entered.

THEREFORE, upon request of the Petitioner, default is hereby entered against the Respondent Julie A. Young, as provided in Chapter 32, §§ 7 and 9 of the Wyoming Department of Insurance Rules and Regulations.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Wyoming insurance producer license held by Respondent is **REVOKED** pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent shall immediately surrender her Wyoming nonresident insurance producer license to the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner.



PETITION FOR NOTICE AND ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

COMES NOW the Wyoming Department of Insurance, acting by and through Stephanie Bryant McGee, Deputy Commissioner, and pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-2-109 and 26-2-111, and Chapter 32 § 4 of the Wyoming Insurance Department Regulations and Rules for Practice and Procedure Before the Department; and the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. § 16-3-101 *et seq.*, herewith moves the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner for the issuance of a Notice and Order to Show Cause directed to Julie A. Young, whose last reported address was 24 Chenal Circle, Little Rock, AR 72223. As cause for this Petition, the Wyoming Insurance Department states and alleges as follows:

1. The Wyoming Insurance Commissioner has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wyo. Stat. §§ 26-1-103, 26-2-109, and 26-9-211.
2. Respondent was licensed by the Wyoming Department of Insurance as a nonresident producer, License No. 213578 issued July 20, 2011, with a renewal date of September 30, 2013. The Respondent's Individual ID is 8933 and her National Producer ID is 1056532.
3. On or about June 4, 2012, a State RIRS Notification was received from the NAIC advising that Respondent's license had been revoked in her home state of Arkansas.
4. Petitioner's investigation of the matter revealed that a Consent Order was entered into between Petitioner Julie A. Young and the Arkansas Insurance Department on May 24, 2012, whereby Respondent's producer license was revoked based upon demonstrated incompetency in the conduct of her insurance business.
5. Respondent was provided notice of intent to file this action in compliance with Wyo. Stat. § 16-3-113(c) of the Administrative Procedures Act by certified mail, return receipt requested on June 6, 2012.

6. Respondent surrendered her Wyoming insurance license on June 25, 2012.

7. The business records of the Department show that at the time Respondent surrendered her Wyoming license, she was affiliated with Humana Insurance Company, HumanaDental Insurance Company, and Kanawha Insurance Company; however, those affiliations became inactive as of June 25, 2012.

8. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-208(a)(i), a condition for nonresident licensing in Wyoming is that the person is currently licensed as a resident and is in good standing in their home state.

9. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(a), the Commissioner may place on probation, suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer's license for, among other reasons:

(ii) Violating any insurance laws, or violating any regulation, subpoena or order of the commissioner or of another state's insurance commissioner;

(ix) Having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.


10. Pursuant to Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211(c), "The commissioner shall retain the authority to enforce the provisions of and impose any penalty or remedy authorized by this chapter and this code against any person who is under investigation for or charged with a violation of this chapter or this code even if the person's license or registration has been surrendered or has lapsed by operation of law."

WHEREFORE the Department of Insurance respectfully prays the Wyoming Insurance Commissioner:

A. Revoke the Respondent's nonresident producer license for violation of Wyo. Stat. § 26-9-211.

B. Enter such other and further relief as may be permitted by law.
